MICHIGAN AUTHOR TO APPEAR AGAIN ON TORONTO'S 570 NEWS RADIO Bigfoot expert Lisa Shiel to offer her analysis of the just released April 16th Manitoba, Canada, Bigfoot video

Lake Linden, Mich. (May 5, 2005) – For the second time in two weeks, Upper Peninsula author and Bigfoot expert Lisa A. Shiel will appear today at 4:10 pm (EDT) on Toronto's talk radio station 570 News to discuss last night's airing on the TV show *A Current Affair* of the April 16th Manitoba video allegedly taken of a Bigfoot north of Lake Winnipeg.

This appearance follows today's publication of a *Globe and Mail* article in which reporter Oliver Moore also interviewed Shiel on the same *A Current Affair* story. The show debuted the video, promoting it as "videotape you've gotta see to believe." When asked by Moore for her reaction to the program's video clip, Shiel replied, "It's interesting, intriguing. Definitely something walking upright but that's about all you can see."

This article follows Shiel's April 20th radio interview on Toronto's 570 News radio station, in which she discussed the potential implications of the Manitoba video if it turned out to be as vivid as early descriptions indicated. At that time, she (and most others) had not yet seen the video.

Lisa A. Shiel has a Master's degree and has studied anthropology, archaeology, and evolution and has devoted herself to an investigation of Bigfoot sightings, evidence, and theories. She is the author of *The Hunt for Bigfoot: A Novel* and the upcoming nonfiction book *Backyard Bigfoot*, both published by Slipdown Mountain Publications LLC

Cautiously optimistic, Lisa Shiel concluded the *Globe and Mail* interview by saying, "It's another intriguing piece in the puzzle. We keep adding to that jigsaw puzzle and maybe some day we'll be able to see the whole picture."
